First Black Rainstorm Warning of the Year

- 1 The government issued its first Black Rainstorm Warning of the year after eight hours of non-stop heavy rainfall on Thursday night. There were reports of flooding in different areas of the city. The authority recorded over 160 mm of rain in the hour just before midnight,
5 which has been the highest since 1884.

Since the rain had turned roads into rivers, many drivers had to leave their cars in the middle of the road. The heavy rain and the floods meant it was difficult for people to travel. The government has suspended schools so that children can stay home safely.

- 10 Because of the adverse weather conditions, neither the ferry nor the underground railway was providing services. People who still had to travel to work had to take either the bus or the taxi.

The government has repeatedly reminded the public to stay vigilant and pay attention to weather updates.

-ed	形容人的感受或情緒
-ing	形容一件人、事或物的特性，或帶給人的感受

例如：

I am **interested** in the book. = 我對這本書很感興趣。

This book is **interesting**. = 這本書很有趣。

當我們想表達「某人感到.....」，便會使用「-ed」；當我們想表達「令人感到.....」，便會使用「-ing」。
